This weekend is the highlight of our Anniversary year as we welcome Bishop O'Connell to lead us in our celebration. I have anxiously and joyously awaited this day, and in anticipation have been sharing my gratitude to God and each of you for the many graces given to us. Today, I would like to share my dreams for our parish. I believe that this anniversary is only a pause in our journey as we continue to build God's Kingdom and serve Him. While it is important to take time to give thanks and celebrate, we understand that God's work for us goes forward. We must continue to grow in our love of God and one another.

Recently we had several brain-storming sessions for the intention of discovering more ways to reach out, especially to our religious formation families but, also, to all of our inactive parishioners. We decided on a motto for our Religious Formation Program: "To Know the Faith, to Love the Faith, to Live the Faith." This is my dream for St. Mary's and, indeed, for our Church. When I reflect on how to accomplish this goal several images come to mind that express the purpose of every parish. Each, in slightly different ways, describes the parish as a refuge in the world for weary souls. When thinking of St. Mary's, I look upon us as **an oasis**. Ours is a place where travelers can stop to be refreshed and escape the dangers of the desert. It is like a **fort on the frontier** where those who are in trouble can find protection and safety. It is like a **retreat house** where people come for prayer, forgiveness, strength and solitude. It is an **emergency room** where those who are hurting, ill or injured can find care, compassion, forgiveness and healing.

Each of those images require a dedicated and compassionate staff to provide the services rendered. **Our parishioners must truly be alive in the Faith to be a refuge in our world. We pray that we, ourselves, but especially all visitors feel that compassion and presence of the Spirit as we live out our faith in Jesus.** I have often remarked that the world "out there" is falling apart. What is being proclaimed and lived "out there" is not working. We have the answer "in here." We need to be confident in that and bold in proclaiming it.

In making this dream come true, one of my greatest hopes for the future of our parish is to develop what I have been calling our Small Neighborhood Communities. I look forward to the day when we will have a team of spiritual leaders in every corner of our

parish that are the eyes, ears and hands of the Good News we proclaim and celebrate at every Mass. This network of active parishioners will be messengers of welcome and healing. They will help our large parish to be one family of Faith.

I believe that St. Mary's is already a refuge in our world, or at least in our small part of it. I pray that we continue to be so and continue to grow in holiness and openness to God. **With you, I gratefully take time to celebrate what has been and to give thanks to God for all His Blessings.** With God's, help after the celebration let us continue to spread the Good News, building the Kingdom for His greater glory!

KNOW YOUR SAINTS

St. *Bridget* (1303-73), July 23.

She was noblewoman born near Uppsala, Sweden, married at age fourteen and lived a happy family life for twenty-eight years, having had eight children. Her husband died at a Cistercian monastery when the couple were on a pilgrimage to Compostela. She spent the next four years there, living a life of great austerity and experiencing numerous visions and revelations. She founded a monastery at Vadstena which marked the beginning of the Order of the Most Holy Savior (the Brigittines) in 1344, and moved to Rome in 1349, where she died many years later after returning from the Holy Land. She had worked diligently, but in vain, in urging Pope Clement VI, Pope Urban V and Pope Gregory XI to return from Avignon to Rome. She is depicted in the distinctive habit of her Order (itself a result of a vision), with a chain or a heart marked with a cross or with a pilgrim's staff and flask. She was declared a patron of Europe in 2000 by Pope St. John Paul II.

ST. MARY'S "NIGHTS OF SUMMER" CARNIVAL

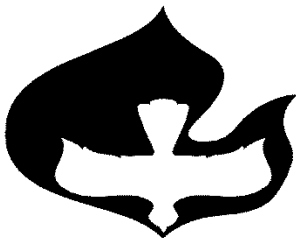

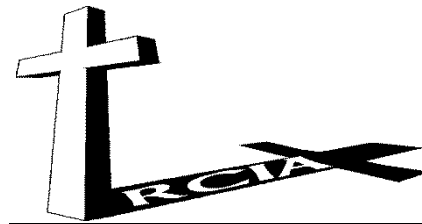

PROGRESS REPORT #7
FAITH IN OUR FUTURE

You were informed in the last PROGRESS REPORT that the Faith in Our Future Implementation Team was waiting for the report from the Bishop's Commission. We have received this report and there were no changes made to the findings we submitted. There were some tweaks and suggestions for implementing our plans and they will be incorporated.

There were three goals submitted to the Bishop's Commission and all three will be worked on. However, one of the goals, the Commission has asked us to work on is quoted as follows: "Recommend to Bishop O'Connell, no later than October 31, 2017, a site for a Center for Hispanic Ministry in Southern Ocean County."

It should be explained that "a site for a Center for Hispanic Ministry in Southern Ocean County", does not mean a separate physical location. What it does mean is to choose a parish that can and will accommodate the needs of the Hispanic Community. That is what the Implementation Team will be doing first off.

So that you have a complete and entire picture in your mind, please note that St. Barnabas in Bayville is already considered the location for the Hispanic Catholic Community in Northern Ocean County. This parish is already making adjustments to accommodate this need.

Cohort #25 Implementation Team will be working initially on this project only and as substantive information is collected, it will be publicized through this medium.

BETANIA III

*Betania III is a community formed by Maria Esperanza of Venezuela who **died on LBI** on August 7, 2004. Her cause for canonization was opened January 31, 2010.*
